OUTSIDE THE GARDEN: THE FIRST MURDER Genesis 4

INTRODUCTION

After Adam and Eve were expelled from the Garden of Eden for their rebellion against God, Eve bore their first children, Cain, Abel and Seth. In giving birth to her sons, Eve endured the painful effects of God's curse: I will greatly multiply your sorrow and your conception; in pain you shall bring forth children (Genesis 3:16). Although the first man and woman through their first son, Cain, experienced the first murder, God in His divine plan for mankind, gave them Seth, through whom would come the Seed of the woman, the promised Messiah².

Abel also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of their fat. And the Lord respected Abel and his offering (Genesis 4:4).
